

**DIRECTIONS TO THE PAULDING COUNTY
TRAINING CENTER & SHERIFF'S OFFICE RANGE
FROM INTERSTATE 20 WEST**

Take the Thornton Road exit (highway 278) - turn right (west) and go to the Cobb/Paulding county line. At the Cobb/Paulding continue to go straight ahead. From the line travel 3.4 miles until you see Marietta Highway (Highway 120) on your right. Turn right and travel 0.5 miles to the traffic light. Turn left at the traffic light and travel 0.2 miles to Summer Hill Road on your right. Turn right and travel to the stop sign. At the stop sign turn left onto Bobo Road. Travel 3.2 miles until Bobo Road runs into Dallas-Acworth Highway. Turn right and travel 1.9 miles to Frey Road and your left. Turn left on Frey Road and travel 0.1 miles to Ivey Gulledge on your left. Turn left and travel 2.1 miles to the stop sign. At the stop sign bear to the right onto Grants Chapel Road. Travel 1.4 miles until the road starts to go into the Paulding County Landfill, at the gate. Do not go thru the gate, turn right onto a dirt road (on your right). Travel this dirt road bearing left at the bottom of the hill. This will take you to the Paulding County Training complex/Firing Range.

DIRECTIONS FROM MARIETTA

Take Highway 120 (Dallas Highway) to Cobb Paulding line
Cross into Paulding County - turn right at first traffic light onto East Paulding Drive - travel 4.4 miles
Turn right onto Dallas Acworth Highway - travel 1.7 miles
Turn left onto Frey Road - travel 0.1 miles
Turn left onto Ivey Gulledge Road - travel 2.1 miles
Turn right onto Grants Chapel Road - travel 1.4 miles
Turn right onto gravel road (Do not go through landfill gate)
Travel 0.5 miles to Firing Range and Training Center

From South of Columbus:

North of Highway 280 through Fort Benning. Continue past I-185 toward Phenix City, Al. You are now on Victory Drive. On Victory Drive, you will pass the softball complex and the Confederate Naval Museum on your left. Turn right onto 10th Avenue. Go to the first traffic signal and turn right onto Cusseta Road. The city repair shop will be on your left. Go one block - turn right onto 11th Avenue. Follow 11th Avenue - it will dead end into the range.

From Atlanta:

South on I-185. Take exit 10 and follow the sign to Phenix City, AL., and downtown columbus. Take the 2nd Avenue exit. travel south on 2nd Avenue to 8th Street. Turn left onto 8th Street. 8th Street will dead end at 10th Avenue. Tturn right onto 10th Avenue. Go to the next traffic light and turn left onto Cusseta Road. The city repair shop will be on your left. Go one block - turn right onto 11th Avenue. Follow 11th Avenue - it will dead end into the range.

From Atlanta:

Approximately 1 hour - 20 minutes

Take I-75 North to Rome-Canton Exit 290 (formerly exit 125)

Take left off exit, drive 2.5 miles until road ends at a light

Turn left, then take an immediate right onto Highway 41 North (to reach Highway 411)

Drive 2.8 miles, then take Highway 411 South (exit on right)

Drive 17.3 miles, then take right at light onto East Rome Bypass, also called Rome Loop 1 (Sign reads "to Highway 293" because you will later pass Highway 293)

Drive 8.4 miles, then take right at light onto Martha Berry Highway (U.S. Highway 27 North). (You will see Oak Hill and The Martha Berry Museum at that intersection).

Drive 0.7 miles, then take left into Berry College Main Entrance

Stop at the main entrance for a map and directions to the range.

From Birmingham:

Approximately 2 hours - 15 minutes

Take I-59 North to I-759 at Gadsden

Take 411 North from Gadsden to Centre (Alabama 9)

Drive to the Georgia state line - Alabama 9 will turn into Georgia State 20 at Rome

Travel into Rome

Turn left onto U.S. Highway 27 (Martha Berry Highway), Floyd Medical Center is at this intersection

Driver on U.S. Highway 27 until you reach the main entrance to Berry College (On left)

Stop at the main entrance for a map and directions to the range.

From Chattanooga:

Approximately 1 hour - 30 minutes

Take I-75 South to Exit 312 (formerly exit 129) (Highway 53)

Take Highway 53 West through Calhoun to Rome (approximately 25 minutes)

Turn right onto Rome Loop 1 (Veterans Memorial Highway) at the light. (You will see Battey machinery Company at that intersection).

Take right at the 3rd light onto Martha Berry Highway (U.S. Highway 27 North) (You will see Oak hill and The Martha Berry Museum at that intersection).

Drive 0.7 miles, then take left into Berry College main entrance.

Stop at the main entrance for a map and directions to the range.

Take I-85 north to I-985 north. Take exit number 22 which is the same as Highway 129. Turn right onto Highway 129 and go to the first traffic light. Turn right at the first traffic light onto Monroe Street. Go to the bottom of the hill and turn left onto Allen Creek Road. Travel 1.5 miles (past the socker complex) and range is the first gated entrance on the right.

Take I - 16 East to the Statesboro, Highway 301 exit. Go North to Statesboro, go through town. You will come to a traffic light and on the right will be a KFC restaurant. Go through the traffic light to the next one and continue on Highway 301 to the right. Go approximately 1 mile and you will see the Sheriff's Office on the left. Go past it, cross the bridge and turn left at the second dirt road. The airport will be on your right. You can not miss the range.

If approaching Cordele via I-75 from the north or south or Highway 280 from the east - At exit 101 you will travel west bound on Highway 280 - 16th Avenue for 2 1/2 miles to 15th Street. Turn north bound onto 15th Street (Bait & Tackle store at this intersection). Travel 6/10 mile to A.S. Clark School. Turn left just past the school onto 7th Avenue. Go to the stop sign - turn right and the range will be at the first gate on the left.

If approaching Cordele from the west via Highway 280 - turn north bound onto 15th Street as you enter Cordele. (Bait & Tackle store at this intersection). Travel 6/10 mile to A.S. Clark School. Turn left just past the school onto 7th Avenue. Go to stop sign - turn right and the range will be the first gate on the left.

From I-85 take Highway 316 to Highway 441, to Highway 129, to Highway 106 to GA 10 Loop or I-20 (Atlanta) Highway 138 (Conyers) to Highway 78 (Monroe) to GA 10 Loop. Take exit 13 off GA 10 Loop. From GA 10 Loop (by-pass) turn right on to Lexington Road (Highway 78 East). Go approximately 2.2 miles and turn left at the traffic light on to Cherokee Road. Go 0.5 miles - turn left and follow the signs to the range.

From I-20 (Augusta) Highway 78 West - look for the Super Wal-Mart - turn right at the next traffic light (approximately 1 mile) on to Cherokee. Go 0.5 miles - turn left and follow the signs to the range.

Take I-75 North to exit 290, SR 20 - Rome/Canton

Go to traffic signal on Hwy 20, turn left at the signal

Travel until roads ends (will pass Walmart and Cartersville Emory Hospital)

At the traffic light turn left and take and immediateright onto exit ramp of Hwy 41 North

Stay on Hwy 41 North through the business district (Approximately 3 miles)

Exit off Highway 41 on to Highway 411 (Rome exit).

Continue on Highway 411 (Approximately 22 miles)

At the intersection of Highway 411 and Chateau Drive / Dodd Blvd (Rome Ford dealership on the right - Huddle House on the left).

At this intersection continue on Dodd Blvd. about 1 1/2 miles, to the stop sign at Callier Springs Road.

Directly in front will be the Callier Springs Country Club. Turn left.

Continuing on Callier Springs Road about 4/10 of a mile the Joe Cleveland Training Center will be on the left (See rock sign). The building sits off the road way (Large parking lot and outdoor firing range).
